

Destination Imagination Region 10 T-Shirt Contest Rules and Procedures

Many teams create great t-shirts, so we have a contest and a prize for the best t-shirt. Here are the rules and procedures for entering the contest.

Rules:

T-shirts must be an original design created by a team member.

Screen printed or computer printed t-shirts are acceptable as long as the design is original and was created by a team member with no help from print shop professionals or anyone else. Adults can help with the printing process.

If a school or town has one t-shirt design for the whole group, only one shirt should be entered and it must be a design created by a current team member on one of this year's teams.

If a school or town has one design but individual teams or schools added their own designs, you can enter the shirt. For instance, let's say everyone in SCHOOL DI is wearing a shirt with the same image on the back, such as the school name and team member's names. But YOUR team decided to decorate the front with a creative, team created design...you can enter that shirt and we will vote on YOUR design. Be sure to hang it so the side you are entering faces out.

Shirts must of course be in good taste and appropriate for viewers of all ages, but you already knew that!

Procedures:

Bring ONE extra shirt or use a team member's, and bring a hanger.

Bring your shirt to the display area in the morning and hang it with the other entries. The volunteer on duty will help you attach an envelope for votes.

Everyone will vote by placing a ticket in a can or other collection device. Each team will get one vote. Your team can certainly vote for your own shirt.

We will announce the winning team at Closing Ceremonies and present them with their award.

Don't forget to pick up your t-shirt after the tournament.
