Where Do You Go? When Should You Get There? When Can You Leave?

Our competition will be held on Saturday, March 14th at Dennis-Yarmouth Regional High School. It's very easy to get to and directions are provided below.

Some sites will start their day just after 8:00 a.m., so we are asking all appraisers to arrive between 7:15 and 7:30 a.m., either in the Appraiser Dining Room or at your challenge site. You can expect to hear more details soon from your Regional Challenge Master.

After the last team in your challenge presents, you'll have a brief meeting with your head appraiser to decide on awards. Please note that you cannot leave until all the scores from your challenge are calculated, in case the score room personnel need to clarify anything. Once your head appraiser says the scores are all set, you can leave. However, we hope you'll stick around for closing ceremonies to cheer on the teams and award winners and to enter the Hat Contest.

What Should You Bring?

All you need is a copy of your challenge, enthusiasm, good humor and plenty of energy. And of course you should wear a snazzy, creative hat! The kids love to see the hats worn by appraisers each year, and you can enter the Appraiser's Hat Contest during Closing Ceremonies. (There's a trophy!) Everything else (including breakfast, lunch, coffee, water and snacks) will be provided.

What Should You Wear?

Something comfortable. You will be working hard all day, probably on hard floors, and you will want clothes and shoes you can move around in safely and comfortably.
