

MADI Scholarship Requirement Overview

Requirements: You must currently be a Massachusetts high school senior who has participated in the Massachusetts Destination ImagiNation program.

Complete the online application. Make sure your information is COMPLETE. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered. We are not responsible for transmission problems so don't wait to the last minute.

The online application includes 1 short essay and 2 short-answer responses. MADI recognizes that not all DI participants may feel confident in their writing skills. Therefore, applicants are encouraged to seek assistance from parents, team managers, or other sources to ensure that their responses are completely expressed in written form. Applicants and those providing assistance are asked to keep the rules of interference in mind and ensure that these written responses reflect the voice of the applicant.

Scholarship recipients will be notified prior to the MA-DI State Tournament.

Application Sections:

- **General Information:**
Name, Address, Email, High School, Graduation Year
- **MADI Involvement:**
Check the years you have been involved with MADI and the roles for each year such as Team Member, Appraiser, etc.
- **Essay by the Applicant: Limit – 500 words or less on the following topic:**
MADI as a Significant Force in My Life – Past, Present, and Future
- **Community Service: Limit - 300 words or less:**
Listing the community service, extracurricular & employment activities in High School and the importance of community involvement in your life.
- **Awards or Special Recognition – 200 words or less:**
List any pertinent information related to your involvement in DI including any awards or special recognition you or your team received.
- **Signature**

Application Appraisal:

MADI scholarship applications are evaluated across a range of criteria with the following considered most important:

- Creativity of essay
- Impact the program has had on your life
- Involvement in the program, past and continued
- Importance of community in your life
